I am requesting funding for the Brevard Health Alliance Palm Bay Community Health Center Construction Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The Brevard Health Alliance, Inc., located at 4315 Woodland Park Dr., Melbourne, FL, 32904.

This funding for this project center will support the construction of a 25,000-square-foot community health center. It will expand access to primary care, behavioral health, dental, and preventive services for these underserved populations, improving health outcomes and addressing critical gaps in care by projecting to serve over 12,000 patients by providing over 62,000 patient visits annually.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will produce meaningful health, economic, and social benefits by reducing costly emergency care, improving early intervention for chronic and mental health conditions, promoting health equity, and delivering measurable health outcomes that align with national public health priorities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
