Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Melbourne International Airport (MLB) Terminal Upgrades Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Melbourne Airport Authority, Melbourne International Airport, located at One Air Terminal Parkway, Suite 220, Melbourne, FL, 32901.

The funding will be used to upgrade the terminal infrastructure to accommodate growth due to new international air service. This project includes the replacement of the current chillers and HVAC systems for the Airport terminal. These systems are beyond their useful life and create a life safety issue when not operating correctly. In addition to the HVAC/chillers, this request includes the replacement of the sliding glass doors. The replacement of the doors is a liability issue for the airport when inoperable. These projects are a priority for maintaining day-to-day operations of the airport for life safety, security, liability, and energy efficiency.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project is consistent with the goals of FAA's AIP program. In addition to making much needed security and infrastructure improvements to the terminal facility, the project will provide construction jobs that will stimulate the economy during the construction period. After the project is complete, there will be more jobs for handling the airlines (ground handling, service agents) and Customs/Border Patrol.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in accordance with 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq., and FAA policy and guidance.
