I am requesting funding for the City of Palm Bay San Filippo Drive SE and Wyoming Drive SE Intersection Safety Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Palm Bay, located at 120 Malabar Road, Palm Bay, Florida, 32907.

The funding for this project will support the construction of safety and capacity intersection improvements at the intersection of San Filippo Drive SE and Wyoming Drive SE in Palm Bay, Florida.
